The Albury Wodonga Hume Freeway will link the Hume Freeway at Wodonga with the present Hume Highway at Ettamogah, north of Albury. The freeway is scheduled to open to traffic in mid 2007.

Abigroup has been contracted to design and construct the freeway. The Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) is managing the project in NSW. This section is fully funded by the Australian Government.
