**Albury Wodonga Hume Freeway – Ettamogah to Murray River
Temporary out of normal hours works associated with freeway completion**

Abigroup has been contracted to design and construct the Albury Wodonga Hume Freeway from Ettamogah to the Murray River. Major construction commenced in June 2005 and the freeway is currently scheduled to open to traffic in mid 2007. Normal construction hours on the project are from 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

The Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) is managing the project in NSW. This section is fully funded by the Australian Government.

Approval has been granted for asphaltting, linemarking, erection of signage, guardrail installation and revegetation out of normal hours until early March 2007. These works are associated with completion of the freeway and will be occur beyond normal hours as follows:

- Monday to Friday, 6pm to 9pm.
- Saturday, 1pm to 6pm.
- Sunday, 8am to 5pm.

1 Asphaltting

Asphalt is being laid along the main alignment and associated ramps from Corrys Road to the Murray River. The work will take place from Friday 26 January 2007 and continue to the end of the project.

2 Linemarking, signage and guardrails

Linemarking and the installation of signage and guardrails commenced on 15 January 2007 and is scheduled to continue to early March 2007.

3 Revegetation

Revegetation of the main alignment and local roads will take place between 19 February and early March 2007. In a process known as hydromulching, the seed mixture is applied using a high power hose from the back of a very slow moving truck.

Where hydromulch is required within 50 metres of residential properties, it will only be undertaken within normal construction hours. Out of normal hours revegetation will maximise the effectiveness of hydroseeding and watering and minimise the impacts on other construction activities.
