Construction activities

Works are continuing along the entire route in NSW including:

- Earthworks, roadworks, drainage works, concrete paving, landscaping, utility adjustments and fencing.
- Embankment and noise wall construction.

Location of works

There will be construction activity at sites from Ettamogah to the Murray River.

Changes to traffic conditions

- Traffic controls at Hume Highway Ettamogah, Davey Road, Fallon Street, Jelbart Road, Borella Road, Hume Highway at the junction of Young and Hume streets and East Street.
- Opening of new Atkins Street link, new East Street roundabout and new intersection with Young and Hume streets.
- Opening of Fallon Street freeway and rail overpass.
- Opening of shared path between Thurgoona Drive and Borella Road.
- Opening of pedestrian bridges at Dean and Kenilworth streets.

Construction work hours

Monday to Friday 7am – 6pm. Saturday 8am – 1pm.

Nearby residents will be advised of any construction works occurring outside normal construction hours.

Motorists and pedestrians are asked to observe all signage and traffic control directions to ensure public safety.
